## Introduction

Welcome to the September issue of the Vicmap Topographic Mapping Newsletter! The aim of this quarterly newsletter is to provide users with the latest news on Victorian topographic mapping products.

Topographic mapping is a vital resource for the State of Victoria, as it is used by the general public, State, local and Australian governments, the private sector and academia. Its uses are broad, including recreation, route planning, emergency response and recovery, navigation, risk management, site analysis, education, flora and fauna surveys, infrastructure planning and asset management.

The objective of the Vicmap topographic mapping program is to provide current topographic mapping for all users, in a number of different scales and map sizes, and in both digital and hardcopy formats.

The mapping products, available since 2004, are created using an automated mapping system that dynamically produces topographic mapping from Vicmap, Victoria's digital spatial framework datasets. Because the program products suite is created from the one mapping system, a state wide consistency of content and currency is now available for all users.

Spatial Information Infrastructure (SII) of the Department of Sustainability and Environment (DSE) is responsible for the production and maintenance of Vicmap Topographic Mapping.
